1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Small Business Innovation Research and Technology Transfer Incentive Program

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Small Business Innovation Research and $\mathbf{5}$ Technology Transfer Incentive Program; requiring the Maryland Technology 6 Development Corporation to administer the Program; establishing the purposes of 7 the Program; establishing qualifications for participation in the Program; authorizing the Program to provide certain awards and investments to certain 8 9 businesses on a competitive basis, subject to certain limitations; providing for the 10 coordination of certain activities of the Program with comparable county programs; 11 providing that a certain award or investment recipient may be required to return 12certain funds under certain circumstances; establishing the Maryland Small 13 Business Innovation Research and Technology Transfer Incentive Matching Fund as 14 a special, nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring the Corporation to administer the Fund; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the Fund, 1516 and the Comptroller to account for the Fund; specifying the contents of the Fund; 17specifying the purpose for which the Fund may be used; providing for the investment 18 of money in and expenditures from the Fund; requiring interest earnings of the Fund 19 to be credited to the Fund; requiring the Corporation to adopt certain regulations; 20exempting the Fund from a certain provision of law requiring interest earnings on 21State money to accrue to the General Fund of the State; defining certain terms; and 22generally relating to the Maryland Small Business Innovation Research and Technology Transfer Incentive Program. 23

(F) ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, THE
BOARD MAY APPROVE AN AWARD OR INVESTMENT IN A SMALL BUSINESS IN EXCESS

23 (2) PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO ELIGIBLE BUSINESSES UNDER THIS 24 PART.

26 (A) THERE IS A MARYLAND SMALL BUSINESS INNOVATION RESEARCH AND 27 TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER INCENTIVE MATCHING FUND.

(B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE AWARDS OR INVESTMENTS
 TO FURTHER STIMULATE INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND ATTRACT

5 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, 6 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

7 (E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:

8 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;

9 (2) REPAYMENTS AND EARNINGS FROM INVESTMENTS MADE 10 THROUGH THE PROGRAM;

11 (3) MONEY RECAPTURED FROM BUSINESSES THAT FAIL TO FULFILL 12 THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AN AWARD OR INVESTMENT MADE THROUGH THE 13 PROGRAM;

14 (4) INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND

15 **(5)** ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR 16 THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.

17 (F) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY FOR:

18 (1) PROVIDING AWARDS OR INVESTMENTS TO ELIGIBLE SMALL 19 BUSINESSES THAT HAVE RECEIVED FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE FEDERAL 20 GOVERNMENT UNDER COMPARABLE SMALL BUSINESS INNOVATION RESEARCH OR 21 SMALL BUSINESS TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER GRANT PROGRAMS; AND

22 (2) ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF THE PROGRAM, INCLUDING 23 MARKETING, OUTREACH, AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.

24 (G) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND 25 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

26(2) INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE27FUND.

28 (H) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE 29 WITH THE STATE BUDGET. 1 **10–499.5.**
