A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Health Insurance – Pediatric Autoimmune Neuropsychiatric Disorders – Coverage

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Medical Assistance Program, beginning on a $\mathbf{5}$ certain date, to provide services for pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric 6 disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute onset 7 neuropsychiatric syndrome under certain circumstances; requiring insurers, 8 nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance organizations that provide 9 certain health insurance benefits under certain insurance policies or contracts to 10 provide coverage for certain diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment of pediatric 11 autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and 12pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome; providing that the required 13 coverage may be subject to certain deductibles, copayments, and coinsurance; requiring that pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with 14streptococcal infections and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome be 1516 coded for billing and diagnosis purposes in a certain manner under certain 17circumstances; providing for the application of this Act; providing for a delayed 18 effective date; and generally relating to coverage for pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorder and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome 19diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment under health insurance. 20

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Article – Insurance

2 **15–855.**

(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:

4 (1) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT 5 PROVIDE HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS 6 ON AN EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR 7 CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND

8 (2) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE 9 HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS UNDER 10 CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.

11(B) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR12MEDICALLY NECESSARY DIAGNOSIS, EVALUATION, AND TREATMENT OF PEDIATRIC13AUTOIMMUNE14STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS AND PEDIATRIC ACUTE ONSET NEUROPSYCHIATRIC15SYNDROME, INCLUDING THE USE OF INTRAVENOUS IMMUNOGLOBULIN THERAPY.

16 (C) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE 17 COVERAGE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE SUBJECT TO THE ANNUAL 18 DEDUCTIBLES, COPAYMENTS, OR COINSURANCE REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED BY AN 19 ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION FOR SIMILAR COVERAGES UNDER THE SAME 20 HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY OR CONTRACT.

21 (2) THE ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES, COPAYMENTS, OR COINSURANCE 22 REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION FOR THE 23 COVERAGE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE GREATER THAN THE 24 ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES, COPAYMENTS, OR COINSURANCE REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED 25 BY THE ENTITY FOR SIMILAR COVERAGES.

26 (D) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED FOR IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 27 SUBSECTION, PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDERS 28 ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS AND PEDIATRIC ACUTE ONSET 29 NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME SHALL BE CODED AS AUTOIMMUNE ENCEPHALITIS 30 FOR BILLING AND DIAGNOSIS PURPOSES.

(2) IF THE AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION AND THE CENTERS
 FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICES CREATE AND ASSIGN A SPECIFIC CODE
 FOR PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDERS ASSOCIATED WITH
 STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS OR PEDIATRIC ACUTE ONSET NEUROPSYCHIATRIC

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SYNDROME FOR BILLING AND DIAGNOSIS PURPOSES, PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE
 NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDERS ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS
 AND PEDIATRIC ACUTE ONSET NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME MAY BE CODED AS:

- 4 (I) AUTOIMMUNE ENCEPHALITIS;
 5 (II) PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDERS
 6 ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS; OR
 7 (III) PEDIATRIC ACUTE ONSET NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME.
 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all
 9 policies, contracts, and health benefit plans issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or
- 10 after January 1, 2021.

11 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 January 1, 2021.
