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## **SENATE BILL 492**

1 In this subsection the following words have the meanings (cc)(1) (i) 2 indicated. 3 (ii) "Law enforcement agency" has the meaning stated in § 3–201 of 4 the Public Safety Article. "Law enforcement officer" means an individual who: 5 (iii) 6 in an official capacity is authorized by law to make arrests; 1. 7 and 8 2. is a member of a law enforcement agency, including a law 9 enforcement officer who serves in a probationary status or at the pleasure of the appointing 10 authority of a county or municipal corporation. "Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission" means 11 (iv) 12 the unit established under § 3–202 of the Public Safety Article. 13 The subtraction under subsection (a) of this section includes the first (2)\$5,000 of income earned by a law enforcement officer if: 14 (i) 1. the law enforcement officer resides in the political 15 subdivision in which the law enforcement officer is employed; and 16 17 2. the crime rate in the political subdivision exceeds the 18 State's crime rate; or 19 (ii) 1. the law enforcement officer is a member of the Maryland Transportation Authority Police OR ANY OTHER STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT; and 20 212. the law enforcement officer resides in a political 22subdivision in which the crime rate exceeds the State's crime rate. 23On or before September 1, 2016, and every 3 years thereafter, the (3)Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission shall certify to the Comptroller the 24political subdivisions in which the crime rate exceeds the State's crime rate. 25

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July

1, 2020, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 2019.
