- 17 (a) **(1)** In this [section, "governmental] **SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS** 18 **HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.**
- 19 (2) "DISTRIBUTION LIST" MEANS A LIST OF RECIPIENTS WHO HAVE 20 AFFIRMATIVELY OPTED TO RECEIVE INFORMATION OR ALERTS.
- 21 **(3)** "GOVERNMENTAL entity" means a unit or an instrumentality of the 22 State or of a political subdivision.

- 1 (b) A custodian shall deny inspection of **THE PART OF** a distribution list and a request to be added to a distribution list that identifies a physical address, an e-mail address, or a telephone number of an individual that is used by a governmental entity or an elected official for the sole purpose of:
- 5 (1) periodically sending news about the official activities of the 6 governmental entity or elected official; or
 - (2) sending [informational notices or] emergency alerts.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2020.
