Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Licenses - Hours of Sale

- FOR the purpose of specifying certain hours of sale for a holder of a Class B–D–7 beer, wine, and liquor license in a certain area of Baltimore City; prohibiting the hours of sale for a license holder in a certain area from beginning before or ending after certain times; prohibiting the hours of sale from being extended under certain conditions; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore City.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 Article - Alcoholic Beverages

- This title applies only in Baltimore City.
- 23 12-905.

- 1 (a) There is a Class B–D–7 beer, wine, and liquor license.
- 2 (b) (1) The Board may issue a Class B–D–7 license if the Board determines 3 that the license is reasonably necessary for the convenience of the public.
- 4 (2) In making the determination, the Board shall consider the number of beer, wine, and liquor outlets in a given area and the number of days the outlets are open, rather than the nature of the outlets.
- 7 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at retail 8 at the place described in the license, for on— and off—premises consumption.
- 9 (d) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the license 10 holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and days set out under § 12–2004(c) 11 of this title.
- 12 (2) The hours of sale for a license holder in an area bounded by Liberty 13 Heights Avenue, Northern Parkway, Druid Park Drive, and Wabash Avenue are from 9 14 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- 15 (3) THE HOURS OF SALE ARE FROM 9 A.M. TO 10 P.M. FOR A LICENSE
 16 HOLDER IN AN AREA BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY NORTH AVENUE, ON THE WEST BY
 17 CENTRAL AVENUE AND HARFORD AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY MONUMENT STREET,
 18 AND ON THE EAST BY LUZERNE AVENUE AS IT RUNS FROM MONUMENT STREET TO
 19 FEDERAL STREET, THEN BY ROSE STREET AS IT RUNS FROM FEDERAL STREET TO
 20 NORTH AVENUE.
- 21 (e) The Board shall adopt regulations to determine the manner of operation of a 22 licensed premises.
- 23 (f) The annual license fee is \$1,320.
- 24 (g) (1) The Board may reissue a Class B–D–7 beer, wine, and liquor license as 25 a Class A–2 beer, wine, and liquor (package goods) license if the licensed premises is:
- 26 (i) within the 41st legislative district; and
- 27 (ii) equipped with high-definition cameras that provide continuous, 28 24-hour monitoring inside and outside the licensed premises.
- 29 (2) The hours of sale for the 7-day beer, wine, and liquor (package goods) 30 license authorized under this subsection are from 9 a.m. to midnight Monday through 31 Sunday.
- 32 (3) A holder of a 7-day beer, wine, and liquor (package goods) license authorized under this subsection that unlawfully sells or provides alcoholic beverages to an
