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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health Insurance – Reimbursement of Primary Care Providers – Bonus**  
3 **Payments – Applicability**

4 FOR the purpose of defining the term “primary care provider” for purposes of provisions of  
5 law requiring certain health insurance carriers to pay certain individuals certain  
6 bonus payments for services provided under certain circumstances; requiring a  
7 carrier to pay a bonus to primary care providers for services provided in nonhospital  
8 settings under certain circumstances; and generally relating to reimbursement of  
9 primary care providers by health insurers.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Insurance**

18 15–136.

19 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

20 (2) “Carrier” means:

21 (i) an insurer;

22 (ii) a nonprofit health service plan;

1 (iii) a health maintenance organization; or

2 (iv) any other person that provides health benefit plans subject to  
3 regulation by the State.

4 (3) "Group model health maintenance organization" has the meaning  
5 stated in § 19-713.6(a) of the Health – General Article.

6 (4) **"PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:**

7 (I) 1. IS A LICENSED PHYSICIAN CERTIFIED IN FAMILY  
8 PRACTICE, INTERNAL MEDICINE, OR PEDIATRICS OR OTHERWISE IDENTIFIED AS A  
9 PROVIDER OF PRIMARY CARE IN A CONTRACT TO WHICH THIS SECTION APPLIES; OR

10 2. IS A LICENSED PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT OR CERTIFIED  
11 NURSE PRACTITIONER; AND

12 (II) PROVIDES BASIC HEALTH CARE OR URGENT CARE  
13 SERVICES, INCLUDING DIAGNOSTIC, TREATMENT, CONSULTATIVE, REFERRAL, AND  
14 PREVENTATIVE SERVICES.

15 (b) This section applies only to contracts or policies that:

16 (1) are issued or delivered by a carrier; and

17 (2) provide hospital, medical, or surgical benefits to individuals or groups  
18 on an expense-incurred basis.

19 (c) (1) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, each carrier shall  
20 pay a bonus to primary care providers for services provided in the office **OR ANOTHER**  
21 **NONHOSPITAL SETTING:**

22 (i) after 6 p.m. and before 8 a.m.; or

23 (ii) on weekends and national holidays.

24 (2) A carrier shall provide for and describe the terms of the bonus payment  
25 required in paragraph (1) of this subsection in a separate clause in the carrier's contract  
26 with the primary care provider.

27 (d) A group model health maintenance organization is not required to make any  
28 bonus payments described in subsection (c) of this section to physicians that are employed  
29 by the physician group under contract with the group model health maintenance  
30 organization.

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July

1 1, 2020.
