A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Utilities – Surviving Spouse of Account Holder – Protections**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain utility, on presentation of certain documents and
4 without requiring certain information or imposing a fee or penalty, to temporarily
5 keep a certain account open for a certain period of time or transfer a certain account
6 to a surviving spouse under certain circumstances; authorizing a certain utility to
7 impose a fee or penalty or terminate an account for nonpayment under certain
8 circumstances or to close a certain account under certain circumstances; defining
9 certain terms; and generally relating to duties of utility accounts to surviving
10 spouses of account holders.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Public Utilities**

19 **SUBTITLE 5. MISCELLANEOUS.**

20 **5–501.**

21 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
22 INDICATED.

23 (2) “ACCOUNT HOLDER” MEANS THE INDIVIDUAL IN WHOSE NAME A

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 UTILITY ACCOUNT IS ESTABLISHED.

2 (3) "UTILITY" MEANS AN ELECTRIC COMPANY, AN ELECTRICITY
3 SUPPLIER, A GAS COMPANY, A GAS SUPPLIER, A SEWAGE DISPOSAL COMPANY, A
4 WATER COMPANY, OR ANY COMBINATION OF THESE COMPANIES.

5 (B) IF AN ACCOUNT HOLDER'S SURVIVING SPOUSE PRESENTS TO A UTILITY
6 THE ACCOUNT HOLDER'S DEATH CERTIFICATE AND THEIR MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE,
7 THE UTILITY SHALL, WITHOUT REQUIRING ANY FURTHER INFORMATION OR
8 IMPOSING ANY FEE OR PENALTY:

9 (1) TEMPORARILY KEEP THE ACCOUNT OPEN FOR A PERIOD OF NOT
10 LESS THAN 6 MONTHS AND, DURING THAT TIME, TREAT THE SURVIVING SPOUSE AS
11 A JOINT HOLDER OF THE ACCOUNT; OR

12 (2) TRANSFER THE ACCOUNT TO THE SURVIVING SPOUSE.

13 (C) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION, A UTILITY
14 MAY:

15 (1) IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW, IMPOSE A
16 FEE OR PENALTY OR TERMINATE AN ACCOUNT FOR NONPAYMENT; OR

17 (2) AT THE REQUEST OF THE SURVIVING SPOUSE, CLOSE THE
18 ACCOUNT.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2020.
