- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take 5 effect October 1, 2020, the effective date of Chapter 407 of the Acts of the General Assembly 6 of 2019. If the effective date of Chapter 407 is amended, Section 2 of this Act shall take 7 effect on the taking effect of Chapter 407.

8 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in Section
9 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
