Children – Therapeutic Nursery Program – Funding

- FOR the purpose of establishing the Therapeutic Nursery Program; providing for the purpose of the Program; requiring, in a certain fiscal year, the Governor to include in the annual budget bill a certain appropriation to the Program; requiring, beginning in a certain fiscal year and each fiscal year thereafter, the Governor to increase a certain appropriation by a certain amount; authorizing the Program to be funded from certain funding sources; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Therapeutic Nursery Program.
