4 FOR the purpose of requiring that the pay rate for certain employees at Clifton T. Perkins 5 Hospital be at least a certain number of grades higher than a certain pay rate 6 effective on a certain date; requiring that the pay rate for certain employees in the 7 Behavioral Health Administration or the Developmental Disabilities Administration 8 be equal to the pay rate effective on a certain date for certain employees at Clifton 9 T. Perkins Hospital under certain circumstances; requiring, beginning on a certain date, certain facilities to ensure that certain new employees are employed in a 10 11 certain position; requiring, beginning on a certain date, certain facilities to reclassify 12 certain employees on successful completion of a certain course and ensure certain 13 employee-to-patient ratios for certain units; providing for the application and construction of certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to the Maryland 14 15 Department of Health, pay rates for employees, and facility staffing requirements.
