1 AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class MD Beer, Wine, and Liquor License

FOR the purpose of establishing in Baltimore County a Class MD beer, wine, and liquor 4 $\mathbf{5}$ license; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore County to 6 issue the license for use by an establishment that is located in a certain arts and 7 entertainment district and maintains average daily receipts from the sale of food 8 that are at least a certain percentage of total daily receipts; authorizing the license 9 holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor manufactured in the State, at retail, for on-premises consumption at a certain location; exempting the license from certain 10 11 license quota limitations; specifying the days and hours of sale of alcoholic beverages 12under the license; authorizing the Board to set an annual license fee; and generally 13 relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore County.
