## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Education - Voluntary Ethical Special Education Advocate Certificate Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to establish the Voluntary 4 Ethical Special Education Advocate Certificate Program on or before a certain date; 5 specifying the purpose of the Program; specifying certain qualifications and 6 application procedures for a certain certificate; requiring the Department to issue a 7 certificate to any applicant who meets certain requirements; authorizing an 8 applicant to petition for judicial review of a decision of the Department that relates 9 to issuing or renewing a certificate; providing that a certificate authorizes an individual to represent to the public that the individual is a certified ethical special 10 11 education advocate while the certificate is effective; providing for the renewal of a 12 certificate; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations; defining a certain 13 term; providing for the construction of this Act; and generally relating to the 14 Voluntary Ethical Special Education Advocate Certificate Program.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 Article Education
- 23 **8–420.**
- 24 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE VOLUNTARY ETHICAL 25 SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVOCATE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

- ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2021, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A 1 2 VOLUNTARY ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVOCATE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM.
- THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO 3 ADMINISTER A VOLUNTARY CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FOR ETHICAL SPECIAL 4
- EDUCATION ADVOCATES.
- 6 (D) TO APPLY FOR A CERTIFICATE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:
- 7 SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT ON THE FORM **(1)** 8 THAT THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES; AND
- 9 PAY TO THE DEPARTMENT THE APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE **(2)** 10 DEPARTMENT.
- 11 TO QUALIFY FOR A CERTIFICATE AS AN ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION **(E)** 12 ADVOCATE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE FOLLOWING 13 **REQUIREMENTS:**
- 14 **(1)** THE APPLICANT SHALL BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER;
- 15 **(2)** THE APPLICANT SHALL BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD; AND
- 16 **(3)** THE APPLICANT SHALL, AT A MINIMUM:
- 17 **(I)** HAVE COMPLETED AN ONLINE TRAINING MODULE OR WEBINAR APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT; AND 18
- 19 (II)PASS AN ONLINE EXAMINATION APPROVED BY THE STATE 20 BOARD ON THE ONLINE TRAINING MODULE OR WEBINAR.
- 21**(F)** THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A CERTIFICATE TO ANY APPLICANT 22WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 23 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE ON EACH CERTIFICATE THAT THE (G) STATE BOARD ISSUES: 24
- 25**(1)** THE FULL NAME OF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER; AND
- 26**(2)** A SERIAL NUMBER.
- 27(H) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A CERTIFICATE TO REPLACE A LOST,

- 1 DESTROYED, OR MUTILATED CERTIFICATE IF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER PAYS THE
- 2 CERTIFICATE REPLACEMENT FEE SET BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 3 (I) AN APPLICANT TO WHOM THE DEPARTMENT HAS ISSUED A
- 4 CERTIFICATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL MAINTAIN ON FILE WITH THE 5 DEPARTMENT THE APPLICANT'S CURRENT RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS AND BUSINESS
- 6 ADDRESS AND UPDATE THE INFORMATION WHENEVER CHANGES IN RESIDENCY OR
- 7 EMPLOYMENT OCCUR.
- 8 (J) THE APPLICANT MAY PETITION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A DECISION
- 9 OF THE DEPARTMENT THAT RELATES TO ISSUING OR RENEWING A CERTIFICATE AS
- 10 ALLOWED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.
- 11 (K) A CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZES AN INDIVIDUAL TO REPRESENT TO THE
- 12 PUBLIC THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS A CERTIFIED ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION
- 13 ADVOCATE WHILE THE CERTIFICATE IS EFFECTIVE.
- 14 (L) (1) A CERTIFICATE EXPIRES ON A DATE SET BY THE DEPARTMENT,
- 15 UNLESS THE CERTIFICATE IS RENEWED FOR AN ADDITIONAL TERM AS PROVIDED IN
- 16 THIS SECTION.
- 17 (2) A CERTIFICATE MAY NOT BE RENEWED FOR A TERM LONGER THAN
- 18 **2 YEARS.**
- 19 (M) AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES, THE
- 20 DEPARTMENT SHALL SEND TO THE CERTIFIED ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION
- 21 ADVOCATE, BY ELECTRONIC MEANS OR FIRST-CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN
- 22 ELECTRONIC OR PHYSICAL ADDRESS OF THE ADVOCATE, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT
- **23 STATES:**

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- 24 (1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT CERTIFICATE EXPIRES;
- 25 (2) THE DATE BY WHICH THE RENEWAL APPLICATION MUST BE
- 26 RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED
- 27 BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES; AND
- 28 (3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.
- 29 (N) BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES, THE SPECIAL EDUCATION
- 30 ADVOCATE MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 2-YEAR TERM IF THE SPECIAL
- 31 EDUCATION ADVOCATE:
  - (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE;

- 1 (2) Pays to the Department the renewal fee set by the 2 Department; and
- 3 (3) SUBMITS TO THE DEPARTMENT:
- 4 (I) A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE 5 DEPARTMENT REQUIRES; AND
- 6 (II) SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH ANY 7 QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS SET BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR CERTIFICATE 8 RENEWAL.
- 9 (O) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL RENEW THE CERTIFICATE OF EACH SPECIAL 10 EDUCATION ADVOCATE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 11 (P) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 12 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 13 (Q) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT OR PREVENT A
  14 PARENT OR GUARDIAN FROM CHOOSING A NONCERTIFIED ADVOCATE OR ANY
  15 OTHER ADVOCATE TO ADVOCATE ON THEIR BEHALF IN ANY PROCEEDING OR
  16 PROCESS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FEDERAL INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES
  17 EDUCATION ACT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
