
2 Resident Hunting Licenses and Stamps – Members of the Armed Forces

- FOR the purpose of authorizing an individual who is serving in the armed forces of the United States to purchase a resident hunting license, resident bow and arrow stamp, resident black powder stamp, and resident bonus antlered deer stamp if the individual is stationed in the State; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to resident hunting licenses and stamps.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (g) (1) (I) There [shall be the following types of hunting licenses in the 18 State:
- (i) A] IS A resident hunting license that enables the purchaser to hunt all legal game birds and mammals during any appropriate season in Maryland without the purchase of additional stamps, unless the purchaser is hunting migratory game birds or deer during bow and arrow season or black powder season.
- 23 (II) To hunt migratory game birds the purchaser must also buy a

- 1 Maryland migratory game bird stamp and to hunt wild waterfowl the purchaser must buy
- 2 both a Maryland migratory game bird stamp and a federal migratory bird hunting and
- 3 conservation stamp.
- 4 (III) To hunt deer during bow and arrow season and black powder
- 5 season the purchaser must also purchase a RESIDENT bow and arrow STAMP or
- 6 **RESIDENT** black powder stamp.
- 7 (IV) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS SERVING IN THE ARMED FORCES OF
- 8 THE UNITED STATES MAY PURCHASE A RESIDENT HUNTING LICENSE, RESIDENT
- 9 BOW AND ARROW STAMP, RESIDENT BLACK POWDER STAMP, AND RESIDENT BONUS
- 10 ANTLERED DEER STAMP IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS STATIONED IN THE STATE.
- [(ii)] (2) (I) [A] THERE IS A nonresident hunting license that
- 12 enables the purchaser to hunt all legal game birds and mammals during any appropriate
- 13 season without the purchase of additional stamps unless the purchaser is hunting
- 14 migratory game birds or deer during bow and arrow season or black powder season.
- 15 (II) This license enables the purchaser to hunt migratory game birds
- 16 only with the purchase of a Maryland migratory game bird stamp and to hunt wild
- 17 waterfowl only with the purchase of both a Maryland migratory game bird stamp and a
- 18 federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp.
- 19 (III) This license enables the purchaser to hunt deer during bow and
- 20 arrow season and black powder season only with the purchase of a nonresident bow and
- 21 arrow or black powder stamp.
- [(iii)] (3) (I) [A] THERE IS A nonresident 3-day hunting license
- 23 that enables the purchaser to hunt all legal game birds and mammals except deer and
- 24 turkey for the 3 consecutive legal hunting days in a single season that are specified on the
- 25 license by the issuing agent.
- 26 (II) The purchaser must also purchase a Maryland migratory game
- 27 bird stamp to hunt migratory game birds and a federal migratory bird hunting and
- 28 conservation stamp to hunt wild waterfowl with this license.
- 29 (III) Under no circumstance does this license authorize the purchaser
- 30 to hunt deer and turkey.
- 31 [(iv)] (4) (I) 1. [An] THERE IS AN apprentice hunting
- 32 license that enables the purchaser to hunt all legal game birds and mammals in a single
- 33 season without the purchase of additional stamps unless the purchaser is hunting
- 34 migratory game birds or deer during bow and arrow season or black powder season.
- This license enables the purchaser to hunt migratory
- 36 game birds only with the purchase of a Maryland migratory game bird stamp and to hunt
