## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Sexual Harassment Prevention Training – Designated Coordinator – University**  
3 **System of Maryland**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that a certain representative designated by  
5 a unit of the University System of Maryland to coordinate certain sexual harassment  
6 prevention training be the unit's Title IX Coordinator; and generally relating to  
7 sexual harassment prevention training and the University System of Maryland.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article – State Personnel and Pensions  
10 Section 2–203.1(d)(1)  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2015 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – State Personnel and Pensions**

16 2–203.1.

17 (d) (1) (i) Each unit shall designate a representative to coordinate with the  
18 Commission to implement the training State employees are required to complete under  
19 subsection (c) of this section.

20 (ii) [For a unit of the University System of Maryland, the  
21 representative designated under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph shall be the unit's Title  
22 IX Coordinator.

23 (iii)] A unit may incorporate the training into existing employment
