American Legion Post 226 a 501(c)19 was chartered in 1947, and we have been serving the Mayo Peninsula and Edgewater Area providing a space for Veterans and the community and helping Veterans navigate benefits, Our Post provides space for community events and organizations such as our commitment to Scouting.. We try every day to uphold the three (3) pillars of the American Legion , Service to Community, State and Nation.

Our Building was originally constructed by returning World War II veterans to establish a Post home for returning Veterans and to serve the local community. The last major addition was done over 25 yrs ago Our infrastructure, HVAC in the large hall, bathrooms, kitchen and portions of our roof need upgrading and replacements. Our well cannot keep up with demand during major events such as our annual 4th of July Fireworks celebration. We are specifically requesting funds to replace three HVAC systems along with ductwork properly sized for the units; materials to upgrade six (6) bathrooms that currently have 4 gal. per flush toilets; repair a section of our roof over the storage area; replace outdated commercial appliances, coolers and freezers in our kitchen; drill another well to support major events. We are requesting funding for materials and supplies only all labor will be provided and or contracted by the Post.
