In 2020, Believe In Tomorrow will start construction of The Children's House at the Beach, the seventh facility in our Respite Housing Program and the third in Ocean City, MD. The purpose of all respite housing is to offer a relaxing getaway from the stress of a child's medical crisis, where families can renew their energy and spirit by spending quality time together.
