10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					

The Ann Arrundell County Historical Society was founded in 1962. In 1976, the Society entered into an agreement with the Maryland Aviation Authority to restore the historic circa 1820s Benson-Hammond House and operate it as a museum. The house opened to the public as a museum of truck farming in northern Anne Arundel County in 1982 and was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1990. The Historical Society provides leadership to the County's residents and general public in the preservation and exploration of a shared local history. This involves educational initiatives at the Benson-Hammond House and Kuethe Library, including researching, collecting, preserving, interpreting, and publishing materials

that document the past.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Ann Arrundell County Historical Society requests a \$100,000 in Capital funds for an urgent two-phase project to assess, mitigate, repair, and preserve the historic Benson-Hammond House. In the first phase, a professional architect will conduct a comprehensive condition assessment and also prepare architectural plans and construction documents. The second phase will mitigate and repair significant damage to the house that is clearly visible, notably an interior chimney collapse into a fireplace on the second floor, crumbling plaster and paint on the walls of first floor rooms, rising damp and loss of mortar around the perimeter of the exterior foundation, and pervasive mold.
