The Boys & Girls Clubs of Harford County is a 501c(3) nonprofit organization that opened its blue doors in 1990 after a group of community leaders determined a need for after-school programs. These leaders saw that youths were wandering and getting into trouble after school because they didn't have anywhere to go that was safe, fun, and educational. Out-of-school time is crucial to fill for youths. The Boys & Girls Clubs of America seemed to be the perfect mix of prevention programs, healthy lifestyle activities, and fun: exactly what the youth of Harford needed after school. Our mission is to inspire and enable all young people, especially those who need us the most, to realize their full potential as productive, caring, responsible citizens.

Our Edgewood Club is in dire need of capital improvements in order to increase security and safety for the more than 1500 kids and teens that attend the Club throughout the year. These resources would allow us to make significant and long overdue upgrades to our existing security system and to add internal and external cameras. The entrance would be updated to include a secure foyer and intercom system. Additionally the building is aging and in need of improvements to it's original roof, doors, windows, floors and lighting.
