The Historic St. Marys City (HSMC) Foundation is dedicated to the support of HSMC Museum. The HSMC Foundation provides, among other functions, advancement support for core and ancillary projects at HSMC. HSMC has been recognized as a National Historic Landmark since 1969 and is one of Southern Marylands leading tourism attractions. The Foundation Board and its contracted employees assist senior administration at HSMC with advancement partnerships that benefit the institution, especially those that help members, volunteers, and donors. Chancellor's Point is a park located within the boundaries of HSMC and has long been utilized by visitors for a variety of recreational purposes.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The partnership between HSMC and Sailing Center Chesapeake (SCC) will expand the recreational opportunities and increase the use of Chancellor's Point Park. Throughout the 2010's, HSMC has upgraded the campground with American's with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant accessibility features and 10 primitive campsites were constructed throughout the property. HSMC and SCC entered into a 5 year land use agreement. The park is currently open for kayak use, fishing and swimming. The partnership with SCC will expand the utility of the park and open opportunities within the Southern Maryland (SoMd) community for public sailing programs on public land. This opportunity does not currently exist in St. Mary's County, and similar opportunities are limited in the SoMd. SCC facilitates middle and high school sailing for public schools and home schooled children in St. Mary's County. Facility upgrades provided by this bond bill will help both organizations reach a broader audience.

28. Comments

This bond bill would fund three primary needs at Chancellors Point; shelter, safety, and upgraded septic. Renovations to the green house which will serve as a multi-use space for staff offices and storage (approximately 850 square foot structure). Renovations will include modernization of systems and the installation of security cameras to ensure the safety of campers (10 campsites), and individuals using the park during operating hours. Safety - Cable connectivity from Rosecroft road to the green house (approximately 1,500 feet). Connectivity will ensure livestream capability for safety of visitors. Septic System Upgrade for the previous septic system that serviced the structures at the site to ensure that future use of Chancellors Point meets the standards of Onsite Sewage Disposal Systems.

Chancellors Point partners: The National Park Service, Access Maryland, Maryland Department of Natural Resources, St. Marys County Department of Parks and Recreation, St. Marys College of Maryland, Sailing Center Chesapeake, Southern Maryland Sailing Association, and Southern Maryland Rowing Association.
