Reisterstown Improvement Association strives to enhance the community by: promoting economic growth for Reisterstown; working with State and local officials to improve our infrastructure and public amenities; sponsoring streetscape and cleanup projects; providing for the safety of our residents; encouraging property owners to preserve and maintain the historic character of our community; organizing festivals and concerts to celebrate our home town. The Franklin Woodland Trails is 10 acres in the heart of Reisterstown. For a year this is where community volunteers have gathered monthly to revitalize the park. The trail provides an opportunity for everyone to enjoy the beauty of nature and relax. The project meets a major goal of the Organization by bringing together all residents, businesses, government officials and others who come to experience Reisterstown.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Volunteers have spent over 500 hours removing trash and debris, establishing walking trails, putting down wood chips, and removing invasive species. At present local scouts are pursuing Eagle Scout projects to support the park through bridge construction, benches, and sign creation. A shelter, and a boardwalk needs to be constructed which will extend the walking trail. This will provide access to features of the marsh without disrupting the habit's flora and fauna. This elevated boardwalk is anticipated to be approximately 400 feet in length. Several staircases with railings are required for safe walking on hillsides. In addition, the first 600 feet of the trail will be paved to make it wheelchair and stroller accessible. This portion of the trail will lead to the children and family Nature Discovery area. It is necessary to have a shed and equipment for trail maintenance. The purpose of this trail is to provide enjoyment for all ages, from infancy to the elderly.
