Glut is a food co-operative located in downtown Mount Rainier that offers vegetarian foods at a reasonable price. It has been in business for 50 years. Glut is a non-profit corporation organized as a Worker's Collective. A Workers Collective is a business managed and operated by the workers. Workers control the assets of the business and decide jointly how the business should be organized and run. Glut uses a consensus-based-decision making process to make all business decisions. Every member of the collective is a member of the Board of Directors. In accordance with their bylaws all meetings and financial statements are open to the public.

Over the last years there has been a general deterioration of the infrastructure of the business. The floors have deteriorated, the roof needs repairs and the basic refrigeration system needs to be replaced. The floors have to be re-enforced and re-furbished, the roof has to be repaired and lots of parts replaced and some of the basic refrigeration equipment has to be replaced.
