The Havre de Grace Little League was founded in 1948 by Warren C. Todd, and has served more than 20,000 boys and girls from our community with tee ball, baseball and softball programs. Todays players and volunteers represent third and fourth generation families in the program. Havre de Grace has the only Little League organization serving residents of Harford County. Our Little League program is completely volunteer-run, from the managers, coaches and umpires on the field, to the folks in the snack bar, to the league officers who oversee the day-to-day functions of the organization.
