The Howard County Veterans Foundation, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization with the mission to provide education, awareness and advocacy for the nearly 20,000 Veterans and their families who call Howard County, Maryland home. The mission includes all Veterans past, present and future active, reserve, and National Guard and their families who support them during peacetime or war.
