It is located roughly 5 miles outside of the beltway in Randallstown, Balto. Co., MD. The primary response area is roughly 24 nautical miles & extends from Liberty Rd & Chapman Road to Liberty Road and the Carroll Co Line; from the Howard Co to New Town High School. We have 6 response vehicles. All of the response vehicles are capable of providing Emergency Medical and Fire assistance.</p>
