Lindale Middle School is a public, community school located in Linthicum, near the airport and the BWI trail. The school has been serving the Linthicum community since 1961 as we were once a high school, so our facilities are unique to other middle schools in the county. Currently we have 4 tennis courts over 30 years old, by receiving the \$60,000 bond, we could support the resurfacing initiative for 2 of our tennis courts that once contributed to numerous county championship teams. Linthicum and its surroundings communities are tennis rich communities and we want to offer safe and healthy facilities to community members, school clubs, and PE classes.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

In partnership with Recreation and Parks, Lindale is requesting the resurfacing of 2 of the 4 tennis courts that are over 30 years old because they are hazardous to both the school occupants and the community. The estimated cost provided by AACPS vetted company; Mid-Atlantic Asphalt is \$51,499.58. By resurfacing the outdoor tennis courts, the community would have a safe place to participate in healthy activity, therefore, promoting community relations and family engagement, while positively impacting student attendance and involvement. Lindale Middle School is interested in expanding their current tennis club and starting a Jr. Tennis Team, since there is a strong student interest. Furthermore, it would allow families and community members to utilize the space after school hours and on weekends to strengthen the family unit, support healthy lifestyles, and learn a sport that encourages teamwork and collaboration.
