## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

Prince Georges County Volunteer Marine Fire and Rescue is seeking funds to replace the current Sewage system/holding tank with a larger sealed unit (to meet current and projected increase use) as well as upgrading piping to the system and raise the vent pipe end to an elevation above the roof line to eliminate current odors experienced especially in warmer temperatures. The current holding tank is over 25 years old with a capacity of 50 gallons. Power outages are commonplace during disasters and emergencies that Marine Fire Rescue responds to and they may last for several days. While we respond to all calls for assistance the Volunteer Fire Rescue company is not equipped with an emergency generator. A standby emergency electrical generator will power the septic ejector pump and other electrical equipment vital to day to day operations of the First Responders and any citizens that we may be sheltering in place due to our location on the Potomac River.
