10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

Round House Theatre produces a six-show season of new plays, modern classics, and musicals each year at its Bethesda theatre - for more than 76,000 patrons last season. Round House also provides educational programs for 4,000 students of all ages at our six-classroom Education Center in Silver Spring, in schools throughout Montgomery County, and at its theatre. Round House audiences come from every jurisdiction in Maryland, DC, and Virginia. Round House Theatre is a home for outstanding ensemble acting and lifelong learning and seeks to captivate audiences with stories that inspire compassion, evoke emotions, and demand conversation. Round House is building one of the nation's leading regional theatres by establishing long-term relationships with exceptional artists and integrating comprehensive theatre education for patrons of all ages into every aspect of our work.

These funds will be used for the planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Round House Theatre facility. The reasons for the renovation of the theatre building at 4545 East-West Highway are to 1) address deficiencies in the theatre that affect Round House's ability to fulfill its mission, specifically related to acoustics and sightlines, 2) increase the comfort of its patrons, 3) improve and update public spaces, and 4) carry out necessary maintenance and upgrades to capital equipment.
