Environment and Transportation

Montgomery County - Housing Opportunities Commission - Selection of Chair MC 1-20

This bill requires the Montgomery County Executive to select the chair of the Housing Opportunities Commission of Montgomery County from among the commissioners.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: The bill does not materially affect Montgomery County operations or finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: In Montgomery County, the Housing Opportunities Commission consists of seven commissioners nominated by the county executive and approved by the county council. The county council must conduct a public interview with each nominee of the Housing Opportunities Commission before the council may vote on the nominee's appointment. The term of a commissioner is five years. The county executive may only remove a commissioner with the approval of the county council.

Background: The Housing Opportunities Commission is the public housing agency for Montgomery County. Established in 1974, the commission administers federal, State, county, and private affordable housing programs. In addition, it develops housing, provides mortgage financing to developers and first-time homebuyers, manages public housing and

other rental units, administers rental subsidy programs (including the Housing Choice Voucher Program), and provides counseling and support services to lower income individuals and families in assisted housing.
