Dear President Ferguson:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have vetoed Senate Bill 261– St. Mary's County – Public Facilities Bond.

This bill authorizes the St. Mary's County Commissioners to issue up to \$33.0 million in general obligation bonds for the acquisition, construction, improvement, or renovation of public buildings, facilities, and public works projects.

House Bill 97, which was passed by the General Assembly and will become law without my signature, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 261.
