On pages 2 and 3, strike beginning with "appointed" in line 21 on page 2 down through "EDUCATION" in line 17 on page 3 and substitute "<u>MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC</u> <u>WITH A HIGH LEVEL OF KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERTISE IN:</u>

#### "<u>2–204.</u>

#### (a) (1) Each year, the State Board shall hold:

- (i) <u>A meeting in July; and</u>
- (ii) <u>At least [three] 11 other regular meetings.</u>
- (2) The Board may hold special meetings as necessary.

# (3) (1) THE STATE BOARD PRESIDENT SHALL DETERMINE THE AGENDA TO BE DISCUSSED AT EACH OF THE STATE BOARD MEETINGS.

## (II) <u>THE STATE BOARD PRESIDENT MAY CONSULT WITH THE</u> <u>STATE SUPERINTENDENT WHEN DETERMINING THE AGENDA.</u>

(b) (1) At the annual Board meeting in July, the State Board shall select a president, [and] a vice president, AND A SECRETARY from among its members.

(2) <u>A member may not serve for more than 4 years as president.</u>

(c) (1) The State Superintendent is the Chief Executive[, Secretary,] and Treasurer of the State Board.

(2) [He] THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT shall attend each meeting of the Board and of its committees, except when [his own] THE tenure, salary, or the administration of [his] THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT'S office are under consideration.

(3) [He] THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT may advise the Board on any question under consideration, but may not vote.

(d) <u>A member of the State Board serves without compensation but is entitled</u> to reimbursement for expenses in accordance with the Standard State Travel <u>Regulations.</u>

(e) The affirmative vote of a majority of the members then serving on the State Board is required for any action by the Board.

# (A) <u>THERE IS AN EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR POSITION WITHIN THE STATE</u> BOARD.

# (B) NOTWITHSTANDING § 2–104 OF THIS TITLE, THE STATE BOARD HAS SOLE AUTHORITY TO SET THE TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, INCLUDING HIRING, FIRING, AND ESTABLISHING QUALIFICATIONS, DUTIES, AND COMPENSATION.

## <u>2–205.</u>

(f) [As Secretary to the State Board, the State Superintendent] THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE BOARD may administer oaths to witnesses WHO OFFER TESTIMONY in any matter before the STATE Board.".

On page 6, after line 11, insert:

"<u>SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That the requirements of § 2– 204.1 of the Education Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, are prospective and shall take effect beginning with the next vacancy in the State Board of Education Executive Director position after the effective date of this Act.";

and in line 12, strike "4." and substitute "5.".
