AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 507
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after “General;” insert “requiring the Office of Health Care Quality within the Maryland Department of Health to notify the Division of Consumer Protection of the appointment of an assisted living program as a resident’s representative payee at the request of the resident within a certain time after being made aware of the appointment;”; in line 6, strike “within the Maryland Department of Health”; and in line 8, strike “under certain circumstances” and substitute “and the Office of the Inspector General within the Department”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 17, insert:

“(C) THE OFFICE OF HEALTH CARE QUALITY SHALL NOTIFY THE DIVISION OF THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM AS A RESIDENT’S REPRESENTATIVE PAYEE AT THE REQUEST OF THE RESIDENT WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME AFTER BEING MADE AWARE OF THE APPOINTMENT.”.

On page 3, in lines 9 and 10, strike “, WHEN REFERRING” and substitute “**SHALL REFER**”; strike beginning with the first “THE” in line 11 down through “TO” in line 13; and in line 14, after “GENERAL” insert “**AND TO THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT**”.
