AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 489
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 10, after “consumed;” insert “specifying that a license holder may serve a patron only a single serving of certain alcoholic beverages at a certain time; establishing a maximum number of servings of certain alcoholic beverages that may be provided to a patron per day; prohibiting a license holder from allowing a patron to remove alcohol purchased at the movie theater from the licensed premises;”; and in line 12, after “fee;” insert “providing that a holder of an alcoholic beverages license for a movie theater may renew the license only as a Class MT (movie theater) beer and wine license;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 17, after “(E)” insert “(1)”; in the same line, after “LOBBY” insert “OR PUBLIC VIEWING THEATER”; in line 18, strike “AND MAY NOT BE CARRIED INTO PUBLIC VIEWING THEATERS”; and after line 18, insert:

“(2) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY SERVE A PATRON ONLY A SINGLE SERVING OF BEER OR WINE AT A TIME, WITH A MAXIMUM OF TWO SERVINGS OF BEER OR WINE PER PATRON PER DAY.

“(3) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT ALLOW ALCOHOL PURCHASED AT THE MOVIE THEATER TO BE REMOVED FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES.”

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 23, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the holder of an alcoholic beverages license for a movie theater in Anne Arundel County may renew the license

only as a Class MT (movie theater) beer and wine license under § 11-1006.2 of the Alcoholic Beverages Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.”;

and in line 24, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
