A BILL ENTITLED

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Public Schools – African American History – Development of Content Standards and Implementation

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education, on or before a certain date, to 5 develop certain content standards for African American history to be included in 6 certain State standards for social studies; requiring certain content standards to 7 include certain topics; requiring each county board of education to develop and 8 implement certain age-appropriate curriculum guides for African American history 9 subject to certain content standards; requiring each public school to include African 10 American history in the social studies curriculum beginning in a certain school year; 11 authorizing the State Board to adopt certain regulations; requiring the State 12 Department of Education to submit a certain report to the General Assembly on or 13 before a certain date; and generally relating to the development and implementation of an African American history curriculum in public schools. 14

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 Article Education
- 23 **7–205.5**.
- 24 (A) (1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2021, THE STATE BOARD SHALL

- 1 DEVELOP CONTENT STANDARDS FOR AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY TO BE
- 2 INCLUDED IN THE STATE STANDARDS AND FRAMEWORKS IN SOCIAL STUDIES.
- 3 (2) THE CONTENT STANDARDS FOR AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY 4 SHALL INCLUDE CONTENT ON THE FOLLOWING TOPICS:
- 5 (I) THE HISTORY OF AFRICAN PEOPLE BEFORE POLITICAL 6 CONFLICTS THAT LED TO SLAVERY;
- 7 (II) THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF AFRICAN AMERICANS TO 8 SOCIETY;
- 9 (III) SLAVERY AND ABOLITION;
- 10 (IV) JIM CROW LAWS;
- 11 (V) THE 1921 TULSA RACE MASSACRE;
- 12 (VI) SOCIAL INJUSTICE AND POLICE BRUTALITY; AND
- 13 (VII) ANY ADDITIONAL TOPICS DETERMINED TO BE RELEVANT BY 14 THE STATE BOARD.
- 15 (B) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT 16 AGE-APPROPRIATE CURRICULUM GUIDES FOR AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY 17 SUBJECT TO THE CONTENT STANDARDS ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF 18 THIS SECTION.
- 19 (C) BEGINNING IN THE 2022–2023 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL IN 20 THE STATE SHALL INCLUDE AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY IN THE SOCIAL STUDIES 21 CURRICULUM.
- 22 **(D)** THE STATE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 23 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 1, 25 2021, the State Department of Education shall report to the General Assembly, in
- 26 accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on content standards for African
- 27 American history included in the State Standards and Frameworks in Social Studies of the
- 28 Maryland College and Career Readiness Standards, including the content standards for
- 29 each grade level.
- 30 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 31 1, 2021.
