- 1 (6) The Board shall develop and submit to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, an annual report on the procurement system that includes information on actions necessary to improve effective broad–based competition in procurement.
- 5 (C) (1) THE BOARD MUST APPROVE THE AWARD OF A PROCUREMENT 6 CONTRACT FOR SPECIALIZED PRINTING SERVICES BEFORE THE UNIT MAY EXECUTE 7 THE CONTRACT.
- 8 (2) THE BOARD MAY NOT DELEGATE ITS AUTHORITY TO APPROVE
  9 THE AWARD OF A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT FOR SPECIALIZED PRINTING SERVICES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2021.
