BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Agriculture Section 2–203(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Agriculture 2-203.The Commission has [30] 31 members. One member is ex officio and is the principal administrative official for agricultural affairs at the University System of Maryland as designated by the Chancellor of the University. The Governor appoints the remaining [29] **30** members as follows:
