- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "RETURNED PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER" MEANS A 18 PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE PEACE CORPS AS 19 HAVING SERVED SATISFACTORILY AS A PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER.

(B) A RETURNED PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER WHO ATTENDS A PUBLIC
INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE IS EXEMPT FROM PAYING
NONRESIDENT TUITION AT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THIS
STATE IF THE RETURNED PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER IS DOMICILED IN THIS STATE.

1 (C) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 2 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 4 1, 2021.
