# Maryland Funding Accountability and Transparency Act – Nonbudgeted State Agencies

FOR the purpose of altering the Maryland Funding Accountability and Transparency Act
to require the Department of Information Technology to include in a certain
searchable website payments made by certain units of State government; requiring
the Department to update the payment data on the searchable website within a
certain period of time; repealing an obsolete provision; making a technical correction;
making stylistic changes; and generally relating to the Maryland Funding
Accountability and Transparency Act.
