- 2 Sewage Treatment Plants Effluent Discharges Impacts on Midge Populations
- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to monitor effluent
- 4 discharged from sewage treatment plants and evaluate whether the effluent impacts
- 5 certain midge populations; requiring the Department to submit a semiannual report
- 6 to the General Assembly on or before certain dates each year, beginning in a certain
- 7 year; and generally relating to effluent discharged from sewage treatment plants and
- 8 impacts on midge populations.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Environment
- 17 **9–321.3.**
- 18 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 19 (1) MONITOR EFFLUENT DISCHARGED FROM SEWAGE TREATMENT
- 20 PLANTS; AND
- 21 (2) EVALUATE WHETHER THE EFFLUENT AND ANY NUTRIENTS IN THE
- 22 EFFLUENT IMPACTS MIDGE POPULATIONS IN THE SURROUNDING LAND AND WATER

- 1 AREAS, INCLUDING WHETHER THE EFFLUENT CONTRIBUTES TO THE GROWTH OF PHYTOPLANKTON.
- 3 (B) ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1 AND OCTOBER 1 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN 2022, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT A SEMIANNUAL REPORT TO THE GENERAL
- 5 ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE,
- 6 ON THE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
- 7 SECTION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2021.
