1 AN ACT concerning

Election Law – Party and Elected Public Offices – Prohibitions

FOR the purpose of providing that certain provisions of law do not apply to certain individuals; prohibiting individuals from simultaneously being a candidate for a party office and an elected public office; prohibiting individuals from simultaneously holding a party office and an elected public office; making clarifying changes; and generally relating to simultaneous candidacy for and incumbency in more than one office.

18 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO 19 SIMULTANEOUSLY HOLDS AN ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICE AND IS ON THE BALLOT FOR 20 THE NATIONAL PRESIDENTIAL NOMINATING CONVENTION.

21 [(a)] (B) An individual simultaneously may not be a candidate for more than one 22 ELECTED public office.

1 [(b)] (C) An individual simultaneously may not be a candidate for more than one 2 office of a political party.

3 [(c)] (D) [Unless otherwise prohibited by rule of the applicable political party, 4 an] AN individual simultaneously may NOT be a candidate for a party office and [a] AN 5 ELECTED public office.

6 (E) AN INDIVIDUAL SIMULTANEOUSLY MAY NOT HOLD A PARTY OFFICE AND 7 AN ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICE.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2021.
