BY adding to Article - Education Section 7-424.4 Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 7–424.4. (A) **(1)** IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED. **(2)** "Intimate parts" has the meaning stated in § 7-424(a) of

- 1 (3) "Nonpublic school" has the meaning stated in § 7–424.3(a) 2 of this subtitle.
- 3 (4) "PROBLEMATIC SEXUAL BEHAVIOR" MEANS STUDENT-INITIATED
  4 BEHAVIOR THAT INVOLVES INTIMATE PARTS IN A MANNER THAT IS
  5 DEVELOPMENTALLY INAPPROPRIATE AND POTENTIALLY HARMFUL TO THE
- 6 STUDENT OR OTHERS.
- 7 (B) (1) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL AND EACH NONPUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL 8 NOTIFY THE PARENTS OR GUARDIANS OF ALL STUDENTS INVOLVED IN AN INCIDENT 9 OF PROBLEMATIC SEXUAL BEHAVIOR BY THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON THE DAY OF THE INCIDENT.
- 11 (2) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ENSURE THAT EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL HAS A POLICY IN PLACE TO PROVIDE THE NOTIFICATION UNDER 13 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
