11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Education**

14 **7–211.**

15 **A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM MAY NOT CHARGE A STUDENT A FEE FOR**
16 **ENROLLMENT IN A SUMMER SCHOOL COURSE IF:**

17 **(1) THE STUDENT ATTENDS A SCHOOL IN THE LOCAL SCHOOL**

2 (2) CREDIT FOR THE COURSE IS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION FROM
3 A HIGH SCHOOL IN THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM; AND

4 (3) THE STUDENT PREVIOUSLY TOOK THE COURSE, BUT DID NOT
5 SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE OR RECEIVE CREDIT FOR THE COURSE.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
7 1, 2021.
