- FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to establish a model policy
 to support the educational and parenting goals and improve the educational
 outcomes of pregnant and parenting students; requiring the model policy to include
 certain policies and procedures; requiring each county board of education to establish
 a certain policy based on the Department's model policy; altering the required
 contents of a certain attendance policy developed by a county board; defining a
 certain term; and generally relating to pregnant and parenting students.

- 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

3 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO A 4 COUNTY BOARD TO ESTABLISH THE POLICY REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

6 (a) A student's absence due to a student's pregnancy or parenting needs is a 7 lawful absence as provided under this section.

8 (b) Each county board shall develop a written attendance policy for pregnant and 9 parenting students that, at a minimum, meets the requirements of this section.

10 (c) (1) The policy developed under subsection (b) of this section shall:

11 (i) Excuse all absences due to pregnancy- or parenting-related 12 conditions, including absences for:

- 13 1. Labor;
- 14 2. Delivery;
- 15 3. Recovery; and
- 16 4. Prenatal and postnatal medical appointments;

17 (ii) Provide at least 10 days of excused absences for a parenting18 student after the birth of the student's child;

(iii) Excuse any parenting-related absences due to an illness or a
medical appointment of the student's child, including up to 4 days of absences per school
year for which the school may not require a note from a physician; [and]

(iv) Excuse any absence due to a legal appointment involving the
 pregnant or parenting student that is related to family law proceedings, including adoption,
 custody, and visitation; AND

25(V)EXCUSE ANY PARENTING-RELATED ABSENCE FROM A26CLASS DUE TO USE OF A LACTATION SPACE TO NURSE OR EXPRESS BREAST MILK.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 1, 2021.
