1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Medical Assistance Program - Applied Behavior Analysis Services Reimbursement

- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Maryland Department of Health from conditioning 5 reimbursement of applied behavior analysis services provided to Maryland Medical 6 Assistance Program recipients on the presence or availability of certain individuals 7 in a certain setting; providing that a certain provision of this Act does not prohibit 8 the Department from establishing certain standards for the involvement of a parent 9 or caregiver; requiring, on or before a certain date, the Department to adopt certain regulations in consultation with stakeholders; providing for the application of this 10 Act: defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Maryland Medical 11 12 Assistance Program and reimbursement of applied behavior analysis services.

- 33 CONSULTATION WITH STAKEHOLDERS, SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT
- 34 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
