BY adding to Article – Health – General Section 21-259.2 Annotated Code of Maryland (2019 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Health - General 21-259.2.
