## Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class MT License

FOR the purpose of establishing a Class MT (movie theater) beer and wine license in Anne Arundel County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County to issue the license to the owner of a movie theater who holds a certain certification; authorizing a license holder to sell beer and wine to certain patrons at retail at the place described in the license for on-premises consumption; specifying the hours during which the license holder may sell beer and wine; specifying where and how on the licensed premises beer and wine may be sold; specifying where on the licensed premises beer and wine may be consumed; specifying that a license holder may serve a patron only a single serving of certain alcoholic beverages at a certain time; establishing a maximum number of servings of certain alcoholic beverages that may be provided to a patron per day; prohibiting a license holder from allowing a patron to remove alcohol purchased at the movie theater from the licensed premises; stating that a license holder need not obtain a certain Sunday license;
