4 **[(c)] (D)** (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Allegany County shall deposit 5 monthly all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section into a special account 6 to be known as the Allegany County Law Library Fund.

7 (2) The Fund shall be used only for the general use of the Circuit Court 8 Law Library for the acquisition of books and other publications, library equipment, and for 9 other necessary expenses, as determined by the County Administrative Judge.

10 [(d)] (E) (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County shall 11 transmit to the county all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section to be 12 used for the general purposes of the court library and assignment office and for the 13 maintenance and improvement of the court's facilities, equipment, and programs. These 14 purposes include, but are not limited to, the necessary expenses for books, legal 15 publications, library equipment, and the services of the library and other personnel.

 Director of the Administrative Office of the Circuit Court for Baltimore City and with the
 Director of Finance of Baltimore City.

(3) Baltimore City and court employees may use the library in connection
with official duties without charge.

[(f)] (G) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Baltimore County shall transmit to the county all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section to be used for the general purposes of the court library of the county. These purposes include the necessary expenses for books and library equipment and the services of the librarian.

31 [(g)] (H) (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Calvert County shall deposit 32 monthly all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section into a special account 33 to be known as the Calvert County Law Library Fund.

1 (2) The Fund shall be used for the general purposes of the court library and 2 assignment office and for the maintenance and improvement of the court's facilities, 3 equipment, and programs.

16 [(j)] (K) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Cecil County shall retain all 17 appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section for the general use of the court 18 library of the county, including expenses for books and library equipment, and for other 19 charitable and educational purposes authorized under § 7–507 of this title or other 20 applicable law.

[(k)] (L) (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Charles County shall deposit
 monthly all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section into a special account
 to be known as the Charles County Law Library Fund.

(2) The Fund shall be used only for the general use of the Circuit Court
Law Library for the acquisition of books and other publications, library equipment, and for
other necessary expenses, as determined by the County Administrative Judge.

[(1)] (M) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Dorchester County shall deposit monthly all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section into a special account to be known as "the Court and Bar Library Account". The Account shall be for the general use of the Court Library and for the maintenance and improvement of the court's facilities and equipment, subject to the approval of the resident circuit court judge.

32 [(m)] (N) (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County shall deposit 33 monthly all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section into a special account 34 to be known as the Frederick County Law Library Fund.

1 (2) The Fund shall be used only for the general use of the Circuit Court 2 Law Library for the acquisition of books and other publications, library equipment, and for 3 other necessary expenses, as determined by the County Administrative Judge.

4 **[**(n)**] (O)** (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Garrett County shall deposit 5 monthly all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section into a special account 6 to be known as the Garrett County Law Library Fund.

7 (2) The Fund shall be used only for the acquisition of books and other 8 publications, library equipment, and for other necessary expenses, as determined by the 9 County Administrative Judge.

10 [(o)] (P) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Harford County shall retain all 11 appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section for the general use of the court 12 library of the county, including the necessary expenses for books and library equipment 13 and the cost for the services of a librarian.

14 **[(p)] (Q)** The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard County shall deposit all 15 appearance fees collected by the Clerk pursuant to this section into a special account to be 16 known and designated as "the Law Library Fund". The Fund shall be used for the general 17 purposes of the court library of the county, including the necessary expenses for books and 18 library equipment.

19 **[**(q)**] (R)** (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Kent County shall deposit all 20 appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section into a special account known as 21 the "Kent County Bar Library" Account.

- (2) These fees, together with other funds, shall be disbursed:

(i) If approved or considered necessary by the Administrative Judge
 of the Circuit Court for Kent County;

(ii) For the acquisition and maintenance of legal publications; or

(iii) For the compensation of the librarian of the Kent County Bar
Library in the amount established in the Second Judicial Circuit Order, relating to the
appointment and compensation of the law librarian of the Second Judicial Circuit Courts.

[(r)] (S) (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County shall transmit to the county all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section to be used for the general purposes of the court library and assignment office and for the maintenance and improvement of the court's facilities, equipment, and programs. These purposes include, but are not limited to, the necessary expenses for books, legal publications, library equipment, and the services of the library and other personnel.

35 (2) Expenditures for the library are not limited to this fund if the same 36 should be deemed insufficient by the County Administrative Judge.

1 [(s)] (T) (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Queen Anne's County shall 2 distribute all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section to the Queen Anne's 3 County Bar Association.

4 (2) The Queen Anne's County Bar Association shall retain the fees in a 5 separate Law Library Fund.

6 (3) The Queen Anne's County Bar Association, with the approval of the 7 County Administrative Judge, may make distributions from the Law Library Fund for the 8 purchase and maintenance of legal publications and equipment for the county law library.

9 (4) All property acquired under this section shall be used and maintained 10 as part of the county law library.

11 **[**(t)**] (U)** (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for St. Mary's County shall 12 transmit to the county each month all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this 13 section.

14 (2) The county shall maintain the appearance fees in a special account to 15 be known as the St. Mary's County Law Library Fund.

16 (3) The Fund shall be used only for the general use of the Circuit Court 17 Law Library for the acquisition of books and other publications, library equipment, and for 18 other necessary expenses, as determined by the County Administrative Judge.

19 [(u)] (V) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset County shall deposit 20 monthly all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section into a special account 21 to be known as "the Court and Bar Library Account". The Account shall be for the general 22 use of the court library and for the maintenance and improvement of the court's facilities 23 and equipment, subject to the approval of the resident circuit court judge.

[(v)] (W) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Talbot County shall transmit on a
monthly basis all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section to the County
Bar Library Fund to be used for the general purposes of the bar library.

[(w)] (X) (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Washington County shall
 deposit monthly all appearance fees collected under this section into a special account to be
 known as the Washington County Court Library Fund.

30 (2) The Fund shall be used only for the general use of the county court 31 library including books, library equipment, librarian services, and other necessary 32 expenses as determined by the County Administrative Judge.

1 [(x)] (Y) (1) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Wicomico County shall deposit 2 not less than monthly all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section into a 3 special account to be known as the "Court and Bar Library Account".

4 (2) The Account shall be for the general use of the court library and for the 5 maintenance and improvement of the court's facilities and equipment.

6 (3) Funds in the Account shall be disbursed on the approval of the County 7 Administrative Judge.

8 [(y)] (Z) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Worcester County shall deposit 9 monthly all appearance fees collected by the Clerk under this section into a special account 10 to be known as the "Court and Bar Library Account". The Account shall be for the general 11 use of the court library and for the maintenance and improvement of the court's facilities 12 and equipment, and together with other funds in the Account, shall be disbursed upon the 13 approval of the County Administrative Judge.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 2021.
