1 AN ACT concerning

$\mathbf{2}$ Task Force to Review and Update the Maryland Recycling Act 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Review and Update the Maryland 4 Recycling Act; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; $\mathbf{5}$ prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, but 6 authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to 7 study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task 8 Force to report its findings and recommendations to certain committees of the 9 General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Review and Update the Maryland 1011 Recycling Act. SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 1213 That: 14There is a Task Force to Review and Update the Maryland Recycling Act. (a) The Task Force consists of the following members: 15(b) one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of 16 (1)17the Senate: 18 (2)one member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the 19 House: 20(3)the Secretary of the Environment, or the Secretary's designee; and 21(4)the following members, appointed by the Secretary of the Environment: 22(i) one representative of the Maryland Association of Counties;

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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 2 1, 2021. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2022, this 3 Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no 4 further force and effect.
