Prince George's County - Payment in Lieu of Taxes Agreements - Low-Income Housing

 $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of Prince George's County to enter into 6 an agreement with an owner of real property who is engaged in constructing or 7 operating housing structures or projects for the payment of a negotiated amount in lieu of county property taxes on the property; requiring property that is subject to a 8 9 payment in lieu of taxes agreement to be used for a housing structure or project that 10 is constructed or rehabilitated under certain programs or acquired under a certain 11 county program; requiring the owner of real property subject to a payment in lieu of 12taxes agreement to agree to certain requirements for the use of the property for low-income housing; authorizing real property subject to a payment in lieu of taxes 13 agreement to include certain service facilities; providing that real property subject 14 15to a payment in lieu of taxes agreement is exempt from county property tax when certain requirements are met; defining a certain term; and generally relating to 16 17payment in lieu of taxes agreements for low-income housing in Prince George's 18 County.

A. AGREES TO COMMENCE OR CONTINUE TO 30 MAINTAIN THE REAL PROPERTY AS RENTAL HOUSING FOR LOWER INCOME PERSONS

3 **B.** AGREES TO RENEW ANY ANNUAL CONTRIBUTIONS 4 CONTRACT OR OTHER AGREEMENT FOR RENTAL SUBSIDY OR SUPPLEMENT; OR

ENTERS INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE GOVERNING
BODY OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY TO ALLOW THE ENTIRE PROPERTY OR THE
PORTION OF THE PROPERTY THAT WAS MAINTAINED FOR LOWER INCOME PERSONS
TO REMAIN AS HOUSING FOR LOWER INCOME PERSONS FOR A TERM OF AT LEAST 5
YEARS.

10 (3) IF THE STRUCTURE AND FACILITIES OF THE REAL PROPERTY ARE 11 USED PREDOMINANTLY FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES, THE REAL PROPERTY MAY 12 CONTAIN SERVICE FACILITIES TO SERVE ITS OCCUPANTS AND THE SURROUNDING 13 NEIGHBORHOOD.

14 **(B) R**EAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS 15 EXEMPT WHEN THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION ARE MET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2021.
