Vehicle Laws - Policies and Prohibition Against Discriminatory Traffic Stops


- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission in 4 consultation with the Maryland Statistical Analysis Center to expand a certain 5 model policy against race—based traffic stops to include certain other traffic stops; 6 requiring a law enforcement officer making a traffic stop to report certain 7 information to the law enforcement agency that employs the officer; requiring a law 8 enforcement agency to adopt a policy against traffic stops based solely on an 9 individual's national origin, religion, gender, gender identity, or sexual orientation; and generally relating to law enforcement policies promoting nondiscriminatory law 10 11 enforcement.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 Article – Transportation

- 21 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 22 (2) "Law enforcement agency" means an agency that is listed in § 3–101(e) 23 of the Public Safety Article.



- 1 (3) "Law enforcement officer" means any person who, in an official capacity, is authorized by law to make arrests and who is an employee of a law enforcement agency.
- 4 (4) "Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission" means the unit 5 within the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services established under § 6 3–202 of the Public Safety Article.
- 7 (5) "Maryland Statistical Analysis Center" means the research, 8 development, and evaluation component of the Governor's Office of Crime Prevention, 9 Youth, and Victim Services.
- 10 (6) (i) "Traffic stop" means any instance when a law enforcement officer 11 stops the driver of a motor vehicle and detains the driver for any period of time for a 12 violation of the Maryland Vehicle Law.
- 13 (ii) "Traffic stop" does not include:
- 14 1. A checkpoint or roadblock stop;
- 15 2. A stop of multiple vehicles due to a traffic accident or emergency situation requiring the stopping of vehicles for public safety purposes;
- 17 3. A stop based on the use of radar, laser, or vascar 18 technology; or
- 19 4. A stop based on the use of license plate reader technology.
- 20 (b) The Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission, in consultation with the Maryland Statistical Analysis Center, shall develop:
- 22 (1) A model format for the efficient recording of data required under 23 subsection (d) of this section on an electronic device, or by any other means, for use by a 24 law enforcement agency;
- 25 (2) Guidelines that each law enforcement agency may use as a 26 management tool to evaluate data collected by its officers for use in counseling and 27 improved training;
- 28 (3) A standardized format that each law enforcement agency shall use in 29 reporting data to the Maryland Statistical Analysis Center under subsection (e) of this 30 section; and
- 31 (4) A model policy against [race-based] traffic stops BASED ON RACE, 32 ETHNICITY, NATIONAL ORIGIN, RELIGION, GENDER, GENDER IDENTITY, OR SEXUAL 33 ORIENTATION that a law enforcement agency may use in developing its policy in 34 accordance with subsection (g) of this section.

- 1 (ii) A filterable data display under this paragraph shall allow a 2 person to:
- 3 I. Filter the traffic stop data by county or municipality or law 4 enforcement agency; and
- 5 2. Review various visuals associated with data items 6 reported under subsection (d) of this section.
- 7 (iii) Beginning with data collected for calendar year 2018, the 8 Maryland Statistical Analysis Center shall include and maintain data from all prior years 9 in the filterable data display.
- 10 (iv) When the Maryland Statistical Analysis Center updates a 11 filterable data display under this section, the Governor's Office of Crime Control and 12 Prevention shall provide electronic and written notice of the update to the General 13 Assembly in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article.
- 14 (g) (1) A law enforcement agency shall adopt a policy against [race-based]
 15 traffic stops BASED ON RACE, ETHNICITY, NATIONAL ORIGIN, RELIGION, GENDER,
 16 GENDER IDENTITY, OR SEXUAL ORIENTATION that is to be used as a management tool
 17 to promote nondiscriminatory law enforcement and in the training and counseling of its
 18 officers.
- 19 (2) (i) The policy shall prohibit the practice of using an individual's race 20 [or], ethnicity, NATIONAL ORIGIN, RELIGION, GENDER, GENDER IDENTITY, OR 21 SEXUAL ORIENTATION as the sole justification to initiate a traffic stop.
- 22 (ii) The policy shall make clear that it may not be construed to alter 23 the authority of a law enforcement officer to make an arrest, conduct a search or seizure, 24 or otherwise fulfill the officer's law enforcement obligations.
- 25 (3) The policy shall provide for the law enforcement agency to periodically review data collected by its officers under subsection (d) of this section and to review the annual report of the Maryland Statistical Analysis Center for purposes of paragraph (1) of this subsection.
- 29 (h) (1) If a law enforcement agency fails to comply with the reporting 30 provisions of this section, the Maryland Statistical Analysis Center shall report the 31 noncompliance to the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission.
- 32 (2) The Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission shall contact 33 the law enforcement agency and request that the agency comply with the required 34 reporting provisions.
- 35 (3) If the law enforcement agency fails to comply with the required reporting provisions within 30 days after being contacted by the Maryland Police Training

- 1 and Standards Commission, the Maryland Statistical Analysis Center and the Maryland
- 2 Police Training and Standards Commission jointly shall report the noncompliance to the
- 3 Governor and the Legislative Policy Committee of the General Assembly.
