1 AN ACT concerning

2 Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Annual Fees

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel 4 County, for a certain licensing period, to reimburse the entire amount of the annual fee for certain alcoholic beverages licenses under certain circumstances; requiring $\mathbf{5}$ 6 the Board, for a certain licensing period, to reimburse a certain percentage of the 7 annual license fee for certain alcoholic beverages licenses under certain 8 circumstances and reimburse a certain amount of the annual license fees the next 9 fiscal year under certain circumstances; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Anne Arundel County. 10

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 12 That, notwithstanding any other law, <u>for the 2020–2021 licensing period</u>, the Board of

18	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July							
19	1, 2021 is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public							
20	health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the							
21	members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect							

22 from the date it is enacted.
